Art work for the ICCF will be juried at the GVA building on Tuesday, November 18. Jurors will include Joel Zwart and Chris Stoffel Overvoorde. You can drop your work off in the GVA gallery either Thursday evening, November 13 during sketch from 7pm to 9pm or Saturday, November 15 during sketch from 10am to 1pm. Kathy Bechtel and Carol Laurn will be there to greet and assist you, taking your entry form and entry fee. The registration fee is \$10 for one entry and \$15 for two entries. Make check payable to Grand Valley Artists, Inc.

Each member may submit one or two works to be juried. Work should be no larger than 35". Art work must "look" professionally framed. No giclees or commercial reproductions. Work must be sturdily wired and ready to hang.

The work juried into the show will be transported to ICCF. You will be notified by email whether or not your work is included. Bring a stamped, self-addressed envelope if we cannot contact you by email. The date of installation is November 20. The show is on display from November 24 to February 6. Non selected art work may be picked up as soon as possible at GVA during open hours.


